College students will work as interns at the event and may gain class or course credit if they arrange that with their respective school. All scholarship recipients will have direct contact with CNN, providing a portal for knowledge of and access to CNN.

Applicants should submit a paragraph about their interest and commitment to broadcasting and a description of the financial need.
